Course Description:

Instructor: **Bill Edmundson, DCJS; Certified Latent Fingerprint Examiner**

- **This 40-hour school will prepare** officers/examiners to properly interpret all existing fingerprint patterns, from the simplest to the most difficult and questionable patterns; to utilize the Henry and NCIC Fingerprint Classification Systems and to properly classify in both systems a variety of sample fingerprints as provided.
- **Training will address**, but not detail, the WCDX and the Special Loop Extension Classifications.
- **Officers will receive instructions** for developing latent fingerprints using powders and chemicals.
- **Officers will be able to** successfully compare sample inked and/or latent finger impressions.
- **Training includes introduction to** latent processing, comparison photography, charting, testifying is at basic level and limited to time availability; additional advanced training recommended for those subjects.
- **Attendees should plan** court and other issues in order to attend entire session with no absences, and not expect early release on Friday.
- **All manuals, equipment, material and training aids will be provided** except pen, #2 pencils and writing material. A four-inch ring-binder may be helpful.
- **Students should bring** a fingerprint magnification glass with Henry disk to class if possible. However, a limited number of magnifiers will be available on site.
- **FBI certificates will be awarded** to those officers/examiners who successfully complete the training.
