Course Objective

To reduce the number of officers assaulted and killed by presenting information on previous attacks, based on the FBI LEOKA statistics and case studies.

Description

**A cost-free** program designed to provide information on issues relating to officer safety, as listed in FBI annual LEOKA publications, *Killed in the Line of Duty (1992)*, *In the Line of Fire (1997)*, and *Violent Encounters (2006)*. Victim-officer and offender demographics and behavioral characteristics are noted, as well as additional data from the case histories.

Presentation Medium

Course content is presented by an instructor. Lecture and discussion are supplemented by videos and handout materials. Exclusive video segments of offender and surviving officer interviews highlight the program. Handouts include electronic copies of the officer safety books and related articles.
